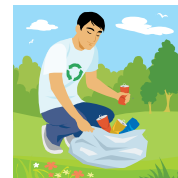
If you didn't get the opportunity to purchase your child's artwork last Wednesday, you can still purchase through the office either in person or by sending in money in an envelope with your child's name and class.

Please read the following information which details the changes when making book club orders:

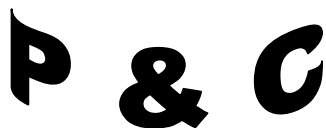
1. All orders should be given to your teacher on the closing date. Please do not give them to your teacher earlier or after that date.
